 but accidentally omitted the last figure of the year 1833 And the said Thomas
 Clarke for himself says that he knew and was well acquainted with the said
 Henry Duff for several years before and to the time of his death and during such
 his knowledge of and acquaintance with the said deceased he frequently saw him
 write and subscribe his name to writings whereby he had become well acquainted
 with the manner and character of his writing and subscription and having now
 carefully viewed and examined the subscription of the said Henry Duff to the
 mentioned Codicil to the will of the said Henry Duff widow deceased he says that
 that such subscription is as he verily and in his conscience believed of the proper
 handwriting and subscription of the said Henry Duff widow deceased
 Charles Goldsmith Thomas Clarke

On the twentieth day of September 1838 the said Charles Goldsmith and Thomas Clarke were duly
 sworn to the truth of the above affidavit before me William Robinson sur-
 veyor of the County of Devon

I Tabitha Roberts being of sound mind do give in trust to my stepson
 John Roberts son of Robert Roberts the whole property which I may see or
 possess of for the use of my sister Sarah and her children during the term of a
 their natural lives except two hundred pounds to the above John Roberts to be
 paid to him within three months after my decease I also give and bequeath to
 my stepson William Roberts one hundred pounds to be paid within three
 months after my decease to him I think it may be particularly useful as being
 in a profession after the death of the above Sarah and her children I do
 direct my property to be disposed of in the following manner which being small
 would be very killing to divide equally among my numerous relatives I therefore
 give and bequeath to my three brothers John William and Robert one hundred
 and forty pounds each I also give and bequeath to my sister Eliza one hundred
 and bequeath to my stepson John Roberts son of Robert Roberts the
Remainder of my property of every description whatsoever or whatsoever
 for his sole use during his life and from his early infancy it is natural for a
 maternal affection for him and I therefore leave him sole Executor to his
 my will

ON the 9th day of September 1838 I am with the will annexed of the Goods

that all my just debts funeral expences and the costs of proving and carrying into
effect this my will be paid and satisfied by my Executors hereinafter named out of
the first monney that shall come to their hands after my decease I do hereby give and be-
queath all and singular the Residue of my personal Estate ready monney
bonds bills notes debts and securities for monney of whatever nature or kind the
same may be over which I have any power or right I may be entitled to at
the time of my decease (except as hereinafter particularly mentioned) unto all
and every my sons and daughters who shall be living at the time of my decease
share and share alike And in case of the death of any or either of my said
sons or daughters during my life time leaving any child or children him her
or them surviving then it is my will that the share or shares of such of my
said child or children so dying shall go to and become the property of the child
or children of such of my said sons or daughters so dying as aforesaid and
that the children or child (as the case may be) shall be entitled to their part
share of the residue of my property hereby bequeathed as and when the same or
they shall attain twenty one years of age or day of marriage the interest of such
share or shares in the meantime to be applied towards their education and
maintenance until they shall attain the age aforesaid or day of marriage when the
share or shares to which they shall be entitled in right of their parents so dying
shall become their own property I give all my wearing apparel and lincens together
with my bed and bedding and all other my articles of household furniture of every
sort and kind unto my daughter Elizabeth Symons and Jane Ridson share and
share alike as her and their own for ever I also give my gilt and silver and
the appurtenances thereto belonging unto my daughter Elizabeth Symons I hereby
nominate constitute and appoint my said daughter Elizabeth Symons
Jone Ridson joint Executrices of this my last Will and Testament In
Witness whereof I the said Joan Ridson have hereunto set my hand and seal
this twentieth day of April Our thousand eight hundred and twenty nine
Joan Ridson — signed sealed and delivered by the said Joan Ridson the
testatrix was published and declared the same to be her last Will and Testament
in the presence of us who at her request and in her presence and in the presence
of each other have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses hereto
